Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Berg seconded to approve the minutes of October 22, 2018 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. All three bridge projects are going well, making good progress on each and the culvert project is being readied for concrete. A safety meeting was held last week that was very informative and productive.

Wood moved, Berg seconded to approve the Personnel Report for Mike Silvers regarding 25¢ per hour spraying

applicator wage increase from \$21.50 to \$21.75 effective October 25, 2018 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Public hearing on proprietors' petition for vacation of plat pursuant to Iowa Code Section 354.22 concerning Kountry Kove Subdivision located in Keokuk County, Iowa, according to plat thereof dated October 10, 1997 and recorded March 26, 1999 in Record Book 303, Page 235, records of Keokuk County Recorder was held with John Schroeder, County Attorney. No oral or written objections were received. Wood moved, Berg seconded to close the public hearing. All ayes and the public hearing closed at 8:38 a.m.

Wood moved, Berg seconded approval of Personnel Report for Kristen Tool, Deputy Recorder, regarding salary step increase from \$36,511.50 to \$38,702.19, effective October 29, 2018 as previously approved. All ayes and motion carried.
